Giacomo Puccini (1858-1924) was immensely popular in his own lifetime, and his mature works remain staples in the repertory of most of the world's opera companies Franco Alfano (1875-1954) was recommended by Arturo Toscanini to complete Turandot based on the success of his 1921 opera La Leggenda di Sakuntala

EARLY LIFE Giacomo Puccini was born in Lucca, in the region of Tuscany in Italy, the composer was often abroad to supervise the staging of his works, from 1891 onwards, Puccini spent most of his time at Torre del Lago Torre is a small community about fifteen based on a stage play by David Belasco called The Girl of the Golden West
